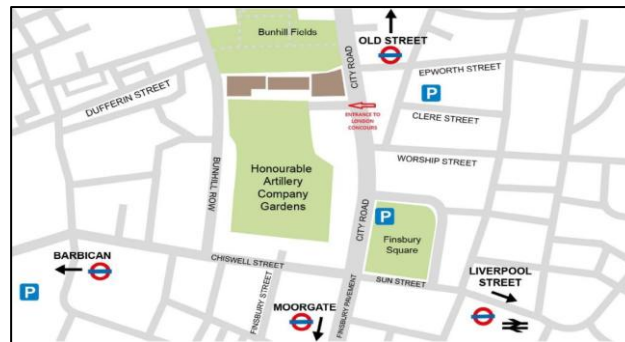

The Honourable Artillery Company, Armoury House, City Road, London EC1Y 2BQ

Please note that the HAC is within the zone for the London Congestion Charge, Ultra Low Emissions Charge and the Direct Vision Standard zone.

PARKING:

There is no transporter or trailer parking at the HAC during London Concours.

If you require parking for your delivery vehicle/trailer, please contact Felicity Rattray.

No car parking is permitted within the HAC during the event, however parking is available at the NCP car parks at either the Finsbury Square or Barbican Car Parks. Click [HERE](#) for the NCP website.

CAR DELIVERY:

Concours Cars can be delivered between 1200-1800hrs on Monday 8th June 2026.

On arrival you will be guided by our marshals to position your car.

Please follow the directions of the marshals to ensure safety and drive carefully to avoid excess damage to the grass while positioning your car.

CAR COLLECTION:

Cars being driven out can take part in the Grand Depart at 1900hrs on Thursday 11th June.

Cars being collected by trailer can be loaded as soon as the site is free of visitors and it is safe to do so at approximately 1945hrs. The HAC will close at 2100hrs.

Remaining cars can be collected from 0800hrs on Friday 12th June and must be removed by midday.

Cars being collected by transporters larger than 12t must be loaded on Friday 12th June 2026.

CAR TRANSPORT

Owners are responsible for the transport of their cars to and from London Concours, please contact Felicity Rattray if you would like to be put in touch with logistics/transport companies who regularly deliver to London Concours.

CAR KEYS:

If your car is being delivered/collected by a third party or you require your car keys to be held securely during the Concours, please contact Felicity Rattray. Keys must be signed in & out and photo ID may be requested.

Image Requirements:

It is important that the images we receive are of a suitable quality and size.

Please email or upload a front view, side view and ¾ front full view photographs of your car.

Images should not noticeably be taken at another concours event.

Images can also be submitted via WeTransfer or Dropbox etc..

All photos must be supplied as high resolution digital files of at least 300dpi and a print size of at least 230 x 280 millimetres. As a rough guide, a file size of 1MB is the minimum requirement.

Please remember to provide the photographer(s)'s credit(s) on the Owner Entry Form if applicable.

All images supplied are considered released and assigned for reproduction by Thorough Events Ltd, for, including but not limited to, catalogues, magazines, PR, books, online, etc..

CAR SIGNAGE:

Cars will be displayed with a sign showing the class/feature, sponsor, year, make & model. Please note that these signs are re-used and **must not be removed** at the end of the event.

JUDGING & AWARDS:

Each car will be judged within its Class as well as for the Best of Show and Chairman's Award, together with Sponsor & Partner awards.

Judging will start at 1000hrs. You will be given a timeslot for your car to be judged and you should be with your car to talk to the Judges. Judging will take approximately ten minutes, so if there is anything important relating to the car's history, please do make sure you mention it.

Due to the restrictions at the HAC, you will not be asked to start the engine. However, the judges will want to see under the bonnet, in the boot and inside the car.

Weather dependent, soft tops should be displayed with the roof down.

The London Concours is a concours of elegance and not a concours of presentation. Whilst the judges will be looking at the standard of presentation of the vehicle, they will also award marks for its history & originality. Details such as previous ownership, where it has spent its life, who & when it was restored (if it has been) and whether it has a competition history of any type, will all be of interest to the judges.

DETAILING & CAR COVERS:

There will be a team of detailers available throughout the event to dust/dry your car as necessary and cover/uncover the cars each day, if you wish.

This is a complimentary service which you can confirm on your Entry Form.

Please leave a waterproof cover (and soft internal cover, if necessary) accessible in your car if you wish your car to be covered by our detailers overnight.

HOTEL ACCOMMODATION:
